ROOTED IN JESUS REPORT OF ACTIVITIES CO-ORDINATION OF KALEMIE EXPECTANT DIOCESE OF TANGANIKA

1. THANKS: We thank the Almighty God for allowing us to be alive, blessed is his Holy name. We also thank the R in J Team for thinking of us this time and sending Father Matthew and Father KEN for the second seminar which was so interesting and important for our expectant Diocese of Tanganyika. The seminar increased our way of thinking and it will help us to expand the groups and make them strong and fruitful. These seminars are for us:

“Keys for men in the house, the keys which help them to go out of the door
Locked and go to make people disciples...
Keys for men out of the house, the keys which help them to enter the group of
People and teach them good news ...Bring them to Jesus, in as much as make
Them have roots in Him”

2. TESTIMONIES: During the seminar and before it we collected testimonies from different Parishes:

1. **Brother KAPILA ZOMBE Felix:** He said that “The RiNJ teaching created new thing in him and gave him spiritual tonic, changes were seen by the people nearby him and in his church they gave him opportunity to lead the Youth group... Brother KAPILA is one of the groups of Lubunduy.

2. Ven. NGOY WA KABILA Vincent: He is the Archdeacon of MANONO as for him: “The RinJ teachings are very, very important to build a church because at Manono after the first seminar, we went back and started 5 groups of 4 persons each, those groups of 4 persons make now 15 groups of 10 persons each, those groups help us to expand the church and make the number of believers increase. We would like if possible for the next seminar to be organised at Manono if God wants.”

3. **VERONICA MUGO:** *She is a mother and a member of a group, she said: “i like very much these teachings because they help us to solve the problem in the marriage, in our village, in a church and even in our life. The recent problem was between a wife and her husband, for six months the wife refused to share the same room, same bed and love with her husband. When the RinJ mothers went to Kamangu they advised her by teaching her the word of God and telling her memory verse from Rom 6:23 and Jn 1:12. She accepted to go and ask her husband to forgive her for everything she has done! The same evening there was joy in their couple and they live in peace even now...Those mothers went from Mamba to Kamangu to teach and form GROUPS...”*



4. **KAPUTO GABRIEL:** *A Mother union leader who did ten years after giving birth to her first born, she stayed without having any other baby until the 10th year! When the R in J Team came she gave her need of having a baby and the team prayed for her. After a year, gave her a baby...She is now breastfeeding a she baby!*

4. STRATEGIES : to increase the number of groups, we made some strategies which God allowed us to use.

-One group of 5 must have one other group of 5, this means a group of 5 people can form five groups of 5 .This is how we made groups so expandable and fruit full. After being taught about leadership , the quality of a Leader, the reward that God gives to the Leader once he is called by Him...We have other strategies to be used in the future if we have resource and guidance of GOD.

5. PLANS: Our plans are very big, still we are very Young, still we are ready and ready to serve the Lord; but there are some things which keep us from, our diocese, the Expectant diocese needs the first resources which are people. Gen 2:7, the second resources are materiel, the third one is financial resources.

To make our plans become true as we are working for making people become disciples of God , Eph 4:12-13, we need and need more supports and prayers.

We plan to go to Nyunzu and Manono, but since we planned we do not go there yet, something keeps us not to go there...We ask the Bishop ELISHA and everyone who need to support us for this program, we welcome him, this departure will help us more and will encourage the group of far away.
